What brings us here:



Last year, members of the Human Rights Council gathered in one of their regular sessions and they wrote a **resolution** saying that quality education is crucial to help people grow into good citizens who understand and respect human rights.

A **resolution** is like a promise or a goal that the group sets for themselves. It's a way of saying, "We think this is important, and we're going to work together to make it happen".

In this resolution, the Council asks the **UN Office of High Commissioner for Human Rights** to organize dialogues with many people including children, and prepare a report to help governments ensure all children can enjoy quality education for peace.

The **OHCHR** is a UN agency that monitors human rights situations around the world, and advocates for the implementation of human rights law.

The consultation you will join is part of this listening process and your recommendations will help the UN Office to **prepare its report**.

WHAT ARE THE CONSULTATION OBJECTIVES?

- ① We'll discuss what **rights** all children have and how **learning about them can help us deal with problems** like bullying, discrimination, gender inequality, and other issues.
- ② You'll **share your ideas** on what you think is needed to ensure all children enjoy their human rights and have inclusive and good quality education.
- ③ And you can tell us **what you believe** people around the world should do to ensure an education that promotes peace and understanding and **helps us build a better world**.

What you need to do:



While you don't need to prepare anything specific for the consultation, **learning about the topic can help you gather your ideas** and have a more meaningful participation.

To get started, **check out the information package we've prepared for you.** It includes:

- ① **A recording** of a previous consultation where an Arigatou staff member explains why we're organizing these events.
