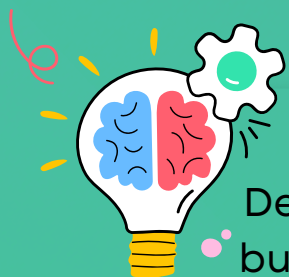
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NORRAG's priority is to **amplify marginalised expertise**, especially from the Global South, in the pursuit of education and development goals.
